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Pacenet Drug Formulary

A formulary is a list of covered drugs selected by Community Care in consultation with a team of health care providers, which represents the prescription therapies believed to be a necessary part of a quality treatment program.

PACE PROGRAM Formulary - Community Care, Inc.

The formulary explains what prescription drugs are covered by the plan. It also tells you if there are any rules that limit coverage of a drug. PACE provides prescription drugs and certain over-the-counter medications for all members. If you have Medicare, your prescription drug coverage is through Medicare Part D.

PACE and PACENET eligibility is determined by your previous calendar year's income. Since 2014, Social Security Medicare Part B premiums are excluded from income. This change has the same effect as raising the income limits by that amount. For most Medicare beneficiaries, this amount is \$1,626.00 per person for a year.

- Drug cost will be no more than \$8.00 for a generic drug; \$15.00 for brand name drug - With Part D and PACENET enrollments, cardholders will receive help with: a). The PACENET deductible, however, you will have to pay the Part D plan premium. b).

Pennsylvania PACE and Pennsylvania PACENET programs

PACENET enrollees are responsible for a \$40 per month cumulative deductible before PACENET will begin paying for prescriptions. Copays: PACE members must pay a \$6 copay for each generic prescription filled by the pharmacist, or \$9 for brand name medications.

If your Part D plan has a restrictive drug formulary, PACE/PACENET will cover your prescription medications or work directly with the plan to process a prior authorization on your behalf so the drugs will be covered by your Part D plan. 16. Effective January 1, 2020 PACENET cardholders notenrolled in a Part D Plan will pay a \$35.63 premium at the pharmacy each month. Income qualification is based on prior year's income and includes taxable and non-taxable sources. and resources are notcounted as income. Part D Partner Plans for 2020

PACE/PACENET Maximum Income Limits

Prescription drugs Note If you join a PACE program, you'll get your Part D-covered drugs and all other necessary medication from the PACE program. You don't need to join a separate Medicare Prescription Drug Plan. If you do, you'll be disenrolled from your PACE health and prescription drug benefits.

PACE | Medicare

If a Part D plan's formulary (or drug list) does not include a PACE/PACNET medication, PACE Plus the program will either pay for that drug or work directly with the plan to process a prior authorization so that the drug is covered by the plan.

PACE will pay for a senior's complete cost of medications except for the monthly co-payments of \$6 for generic drugs and \$9 for brand name drugs. PACENET has similar benefits but has co-payments of \$8 for generics and \$15 for brand name drugs. The above co-payments are for a supply of 30 days. There are no costs to enroll in the PACE program.
