Nadab and Abihu had been with Moses at the foot of Mount Sinai, and they had seen the presence and glory of God. Perhaps because they were the oldest of the four sons, Nadab and Abihu were appointed to minister in the tabernacle.

The sons of Aaron were Eleazar, Ithamar, and Nadab and Abihu. A descendant of Aaron is an Aaronite, or Kohen, meaning Priest. Any non-Aaronic Levite—i.e., descended from Levi but not from Aaron—assisted the Levitical priests of the family of Aaron in the care of the tabernacle; later of the temple.

Aaron the High Priest (Aharon Hakohen) was the first high priest of the Israelites, as recorded in the Hebrew Bible. He was born in Egypt and served in the Tabernacle throughout most of the 40 years that the Jews traveled through the desert. Eleazar was born in Egypt, son of Aaron and Elisheba. Concerning his own marriage, the Bible says only that he married "one of the daughters of Putiel." (Exodus 6:25) This Putiel is not identified further in the Bible, and could have been a Levite or a member of any other tribe of Israel.
